

Achievements and Perspectives for CO₂ Utilisation in Europe

Carbon Capture & Utilisation (CCU) is developing rapidly as a new industry sector, driven by the need to mitigate climate change and to find alternative renewable feedstock in replacement for oil & gas. In recent months, CCU received increased attention in the press and the European Commission has recently intensified its investigations of various policy and market framework measures which could be undertaken to support its development.

In his speech, Damien Dallemagne will explain how pioneers along the CO₂ utilisation value chain joined forces in November 2017 to create CO₂ Value Europe, an industry association 100% dedicated to accelerating the development of CCU technologies and their deployment on the market. He will review achievements to date and challenges that still lie ahead on several fronts: awareness and acceptance, demonstration of environmental benefits, technology development and upscaling, economic demonstration and policy framework, etc.
