Title: The New EU Policy Landscape for CCU: REDII and ETS

The new renewable energy framework of the European Union, coming into force in 2020, includes support measures for transport fuels won from carbon capture and utilisation. It is the first time that such measures are part of a regulatory document on EU level. During the negotiations preceding the agreement on the revised Renewable Energy Directive (REDII), it became clear that many policy makers were previously not aware of the potential of the technology.

Within a relatively short time, the topic grew roots in Brussels' discourses. Both sceptics and supporters made loud claims and for the most part, it was unclear whether CCU would be included favourably in the Directive or not. The same goes for the recent ETS revision, new and heated discussions brought on by the ruling in the case of Schaefer Kalk.
